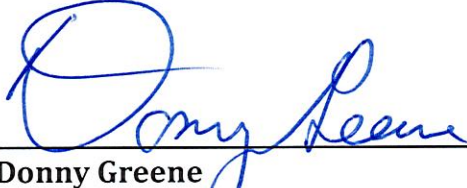

Eddie Hebert, Assistant Director, led the discussion regarding the 2023 Budget that was under review by the Board. Explained by Mr. Hebert, that the previous individual district budget line codes would still be in use until the Fund Balance for that district was absorbed. The individual budgets currently are in use for any Capital Improvement projects and the Debris Removal program. After the (862) Consolidated Budget was reviewed, Mr. Quinn motioned to approve the budget as presented with a second from Mr. Gobert. There were no objections and the vote passed unanimously.
